YOUR RIGHTS AS A CLIENT OF KUNA COUNSELING CENTER

TO CONFIDENTIALITY of records. The Health Information Privacy Protection Act (HIPPA) states that information in your records may not be given to any other person without your written consent or a court subpoena. However, if you are dangerous to yourself or others, mental health professionals have the responsibility to report information to appropriate persons with or without consent of the client. A copy of KCC's privacy rules are posted in the lobby and on our website: www.kunacounselingcenter.com.

- Mental health professionals also have the right, when they deem necessary, to consult with another member of a supervisory and clinical team regarding treatment.
- Under no other circumstances may the therapist communicate information about you outside KCC.
- HIPPA Privacy rules are posted in the lobby and you may have a copy upon request.
- If you request that your records be sent to another professional or agency, your request will be fulfilled with promptness upon receipt of your written request for transfer of information and provided there is no outstanding balance on your KCC account. There also may be an additional fee associated with this request.

TO LEAVE the premises at any time. You are not to be detained against your wishes unless you are a danger to yourself or others.

TO REFUSE any service which you do not want and to discontinue any services you have already started. However, if you choose to discontinue treatment against professional advice, a notification to that effect could be placed in your records. In the event of court-ordered clients, the terms of the court may supersede this right.

TO BE ADVISED in writing of all the services offered by KCC. The scope of the clinical services offered by KCC includes:

- Premarital counseling
- Marital therapy, including enrichment and problems of communication, marital discord, domestic violence, and sexual adjustment.
- Family therapy, including discipline problems with children, school adjustment problems, adolescent rebellion, problems precipitated by loss of family members through death, desertion, occupational service, imprisonment, problems precipitated by the addition of family members through birth, adoption, foster care, or new living arrangements.
- Individual therapy, including issues of depression, anxiety, self-assertiveness and confidence, and life adjustment.
- Mental Health issues such as substance abuse, trauma and grief/loss counseling.
- Divorce counseling and adjustment, including mourning the loss of the former marriage and acceptance of a new lifestyle and identity.
- Single parent counseling, including any of the issues listed above plus the stresses of parenting as a single person.
- Counseling with single adults around issues related to the family in which they grew up as a child.

Services of the KCC do not include:

- Custody evaluations.
- Prescription of medications or treatment of problems for which medication or hospitalization may be the treatment of choice.

At least one parent must be involved in the therapy of any minor children.
